Thank you for your interest in earning college credits while in high school. In order for students to be enrolled in the courses listed under Step 4, students are required to apply for funding through the state of Ohio. If a student does not receive funding after submitting an application, he will be able to stay in the class but only for AP credit.

In an effort to streamline your application process for the College Credit Plus courses taken on Benedictine Campus through Cleveland State University I have compiled the following checklist. Please follow these steps:

- 1) Apply to Cleveland State's CCP program Application is here: http://bit.ly/CSU_CCP_APP (By March 24th)
- 2) Send a letter of intent through email to the State of Ohio found here: http://bit.ly/CCP_LOI (By April 1st)
- 3) You will receive a letter of acceptance from CSU. You will need a digital copy for your SAFE application.
- 4) Apply for funding through the State of Ohio Safe Account. <https://safe.ode.state.oh.us/portal>
