

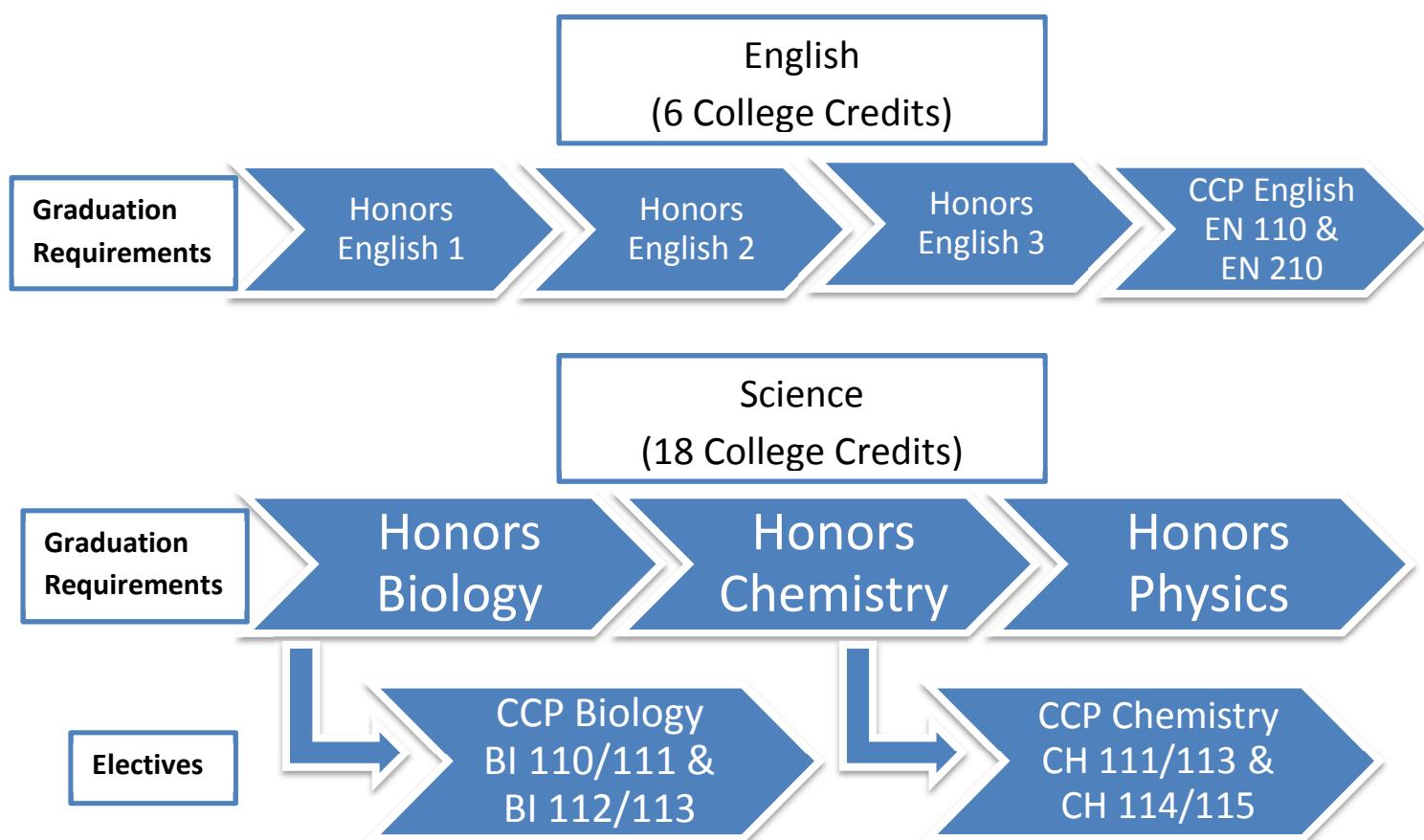
College Credit Plus Pathway to College Credit

(Formerly Known as Post-Secondary Education)

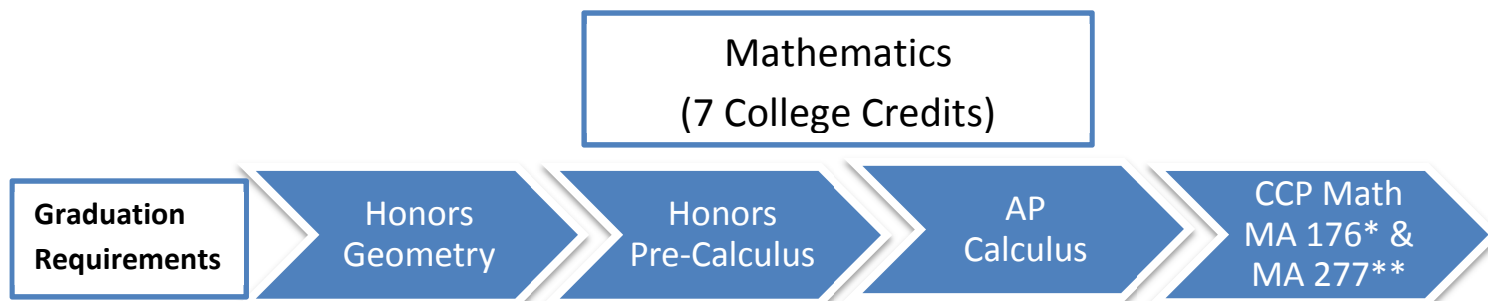
Students at Benedictine have the opportunity to take college classes through a program named College Credit Plus (CCP). This program was titled PSEO until 2015 when the state implemented a title change and a change to the funding model. These are courses that are taught at a college level both at Benedictine and on college campuses. Students receive both high school and college credit.

We are asked to post a model where students can receive 15 and 30 credits through one institution. Below are three common areas we utilize College Credit Plus at Notre Dame College. NDC is not the only college Benedictine is partnered with and your son could take classes at a local college if he meets the states requirements of being college ready. All CCP must be pre-approved through the Academic dean, but if you have questions about the program or process please talk to your students' school counselor.
