Welcome to the BenMed Program at Benedictine High School which seeks to prepare young men who desire to explore the Medical Professions before undergraduate college studies. With this program, Benedictine High School becomes the first east-side Catholic high school in Cleveland to offer this experience. We are proud to be partnered with Saint Vincent Charity Medical Center and their educational staff.

#### The Program aims to:

- Provide students with a realistic idea of academic coursework in preparation for a Pre-Med program.
- Provide students with a larger view as to the issues that are integral to the Medical Profession such as empathy, compassion, science skills, work ethic, and an exploration of situations that are faced every day by medical professionals.
- Provide students with a realistic look at the variety involved in medical professions including nursing, general practice, pediatrics, specialized medicine, surgery, and veterinary sciences.
- Provide students with experiences that enable them to evaluate their own potential for future careers in the medical field.
- Provide students with the opportunity to develop their talents and interest in the medical field as a possibility for future career options.

The Program is open to students in grades 9 and 10, who provide the following and meet the criteria as outlined by the BenMed Advisory Team:

#### For incoming students:

- 8<sup>th</sup> grade transcripts
- Iowa Test of Basic Skills results
- Letter of Recommendation from 7th or 8th grade Science Teacher and 8th grade Math Teacher
- Letter of involvement in a service project from responsible adult, if possible.
- Benedictine High School admissions examination

#### For current students in grade 9:

- Recommendation of Honors Biology instructor
- Interview with the Academic Dean and Program Director
- Review of the student's overall academic progress.
